North American premiere of Vertical Cinema at the SXSW Festival

The monumental audiovisual experience Vertical Cinema will premiere in North America at the South by Southwest Festival (SXSW) in Austin, Texas. Because of the interdisciplinary and experimental nature of the project, its questioning of the characteristics of cinema and its massive sounds, Vertical Cinema is included in the Music as well as the Film programmes at SXSW. There will be a double screening on 17 March 2015. Vertical Cinema is a Sonic Acts production.

Vertical Cinema 'abandons' traditional cinema formats and rotates the image onto a new axis, rethinking the actual projection space and opening it up to alternative artistic approaches. The project presents a series of ten commissioned large-scale-works on 35 mm celluloid, which are projected in vertical cinemascope with a custom-built projector. The works offer a unique blend of abstract cinema, structural experiments, found footage, and live laser action captured on film, accompanied by immersive soundscapes and new compositions.
